

Workstation Migration for OpenLab CDS ChemStation Edition to OpenLab CDS

Overview

OpenLab CDS versions 2.2 and higher comes with a migration tool that automates the process of migrating data, instrument information, and user information, from OpenLab CDS ChemStation Edition versions C.01.05, C.01.06, and C.01.07. This tool reduces a manual migration time of approximately four hours to less than half an hour.

Using the migration tool will allow you to:

- Reuse ChemStation Edition data and results in OpenLab CDS Workstation
- Import and reuse methods from ChemStation Edition in OpenLab CDS including compound identification settings and integration events
 - Method import is manual if using OpenLab CDS version 2.2
- Complete the transfer of the following user and instrument information
 - Users, user groups, roles and permissions
 - Instrument configurations
- Create series of reports on the details of export and how it is mapped to OpenLab CDS



Migration Steps

- 1. **Planning step** Verify instrument and driver compatibilities, confirm PC operating system and software versions.
- Export step This will export raw and results data, shared services information, instrument configuration, and user roles to a USB drive or a networked location. It will create an Export Destination folder containing
 - a. The ChemStation data (ChemStation Export.zip)
 - b. A report of all the files included in the OpenLab CDS ChemStation Edition export that are in the ChemStation Export zip package. (Export_file_report.pdf)
 - c. A report containing instrument information report. (Instrument Configuration Report.html)
 - d. User and permission data including security, authentication, roles, administration information, and instrument configuration. (OpenLabSharedServicesExport.zip)
 - e. Import mapping file. (Package.descriptor.xml)
 - f. A report containing user role information. (Role Report.html)
 - g. A report containing users and groups. (User and Group Report.html)
- Import step This will import the data from the export location into the newly Installed OpenLab CDS Workstation. The following tasks are performed:
 - a. Creation of a default project group with sub-projects for each instrument.
 - b. Extraction of data into OpenLab CDS via a staging location.
 - c. Creation of users, groups and roles to match OpenLab CDS ChemStation Edition.
 - d. Creation of active instruments to match OpenLab CDS ChemStation Edition.




Figure 1. When the migration tool is launched, it will verify that a supported version of ChemStation exists on the source workstation.
